

VILLAGE OF PALMYRA BOARD OF TRUSTEES

Regular Mtg.

May 3, 1993

7:00 p.m.

PRESENT: Mayor James G. Elliott, Trustees Kathleen Drews and Daniel Wooden, also Deputy Mayor Thomas Lynch arrived at 7:45 p.m. and Trustee C. D. Gilmore arrived at 7:10 p.m. Chief Dalton and Harold Baker, President of Fair Association.

CALL TO ORDER: Mayor Elliott called the meeting to order at 7:04 p.m.

HAROLD BAKER, PRES. FAIR ASSOC.: Mr. Baker asked if the ltrs. had been sent to the residents surrounding the Fairgrounds for their opinion on the use of the Fairgrounds for the Mormon Camping in July. Mayor Elliott said he was working on it and they would go out next week. Mr. Baker asked about the R-1 zoning of the Fairgrounds and why the Fairgrounds were not grandfathered in. Mayor Elliott noted that the Fairgrounds was grandfathered in, however, only for agricultural events. Mr. Baker asked why many other business were put in R-1 districts well after the fairgrounds. Rezoning a parcel was discussed but Mayor Elliott stated the VOP cannot spot-zoning. Mr. Baker asked about the Comm. Ctr.'s zoning and Mayor Elliott responded that any municipalities are exempt from its own laws. Mr. Baker noted that some things at the Comm. Ctr. do not abide by the useage regulations. Trustee Wooden noted Sherburne in a R-1 district and said that the main use of the Fairgrounds is agricultural which can continue after zoning but some other use would need a variance. Mr. Baker noted that zoning should not be a detriment but a benefit, possibly the fairgrounds should ask the VB what it wants the fairgrounds to there, there are so many restrictions. Mayor Elliott pointed out that the fairgrounds only needed permission from the VB, but others would need a variance to change use.

DOG SCHOOL: K. Diefendorf, ACO, requested attendance to the Delhi School on Dog Training. Cost is \$175 tuition with expenses extra. VOP share would be approx. \$300 with TOP share the same. TOP authorized ACO going if VOP would agree also. Trustee Drews explained the school and items that would be covered.

Trustee Drews moved that the VB allow K. Diefendorf, ACO, to attend the Delhi School in June and pay 1/2 of the expenses up to \$300, seconded by Trustee Wooden, discussion on advance for expense money occurred and although not usually done, Mayor Elliott told ACO to see the Treasurer in the morning for an advance. Trustee Drews noted that she had spoken to the school at Delhi for information, Trustee Wooden emphasized that if the State is giving the class it is the best qualified. Vote, 4 ayes, **CARRIED.**

A motion was made by Trustee Drews to give K. Diefendorf a cash advance not to exceed \$300, seconded by Trustee Gilmore, vote, 5 ayes, **CARRIED.**

MINUTES: Trustee Wooden moved to approve the minutes of 3-15-93, 4-5-93, and 4-26-93 and tabling minutes from 4-19-93 making them available to the public, seconded by Mayor Elliott, vote, 4 ayes, **CARRIED.**

MERCY FLIGHT: Mayor Elliott reported on the Mercy Flight Public Hearing held by the EMS Council at the Ontario Cty Training Facility in Canandaigua. Trustee Wooden thought this had been proposed before and a map had been sent. Mayor Elliott said it had been but they requested money to offer the service. Trustee Gilmore wanted to make sure the Fire Dept. and the PVA had the information.

FLAG POLE: Mayor Elliott moved the following: Be it resolved that the Board of Trustees of the Village of Palmyra does hereby establish a reserve fund titled "Flagpole" said fund to receive

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funds as allotted by the Board. Funds and income to be expended only for repairs and maintenance of the Village Flagpole located at the intersection of Main Street East and Fayette Street. Said expenditures subject to permissive referendum under New York State Village Law, seconded by Trustee Gilmore, vote, 4 ayes, CARRIED.

Mayor Elliott moved that the Village Treasurer be authorized to transfer \$575 or balance from account A7521.2, "Flagpole" to a savings account established for reserve fund entitled "Flagpole", seconded by Trustee Gilmore, vote, 4 ayes, CARRIED.

Mayor Elliott moved that the Village Treasurer be authorized to make the necessary transfers to balance line items which are over expensed at the end of the current fiscal year, seconded by Trustee Gilmore, Mayor Elliott explained that at the end of the fiscal year no line items are to be over expensed and by doing now no special meeting will be needed, vote, 4 ayes, CARRIED.

WCVO: Mayor Elliott moved that all VB members, Office Staff, and Village Attorney be authorized to attend the WCVO mtg. at Cinelli's in Sodas on May 19, 1993, seconded by Trustee Gilmore, vote, 4 ayes, CARRIED.

ABSTRACT #22 AND ABSTRACT #23: Mayor Elliott moved to authorize the Village Treasurer to pay vouchers 1096 through 1097 totalling \$2,575 on Abstract #22 and on Abstract #23, 1098 through 1141 totalling totalling \$34,097.24 and a vouchers 1142 and 1143 totalling \$300 for the ACO cash advance and school tuition for Delhi, on which appears the signatures of three VB members, vote, 4 ayes, CARRIED.

PARADE-MEMORIAL DAY: The parade will be held on 5-31-93 at 9:00 a.m. Ltr. will be sent to the DOT for permission.

FD RIGHT TO KNOW: Trustee Gilmore moved to approve the FD Right to Know program as submitted by Asst. Chief T. Wiedrick and the Fire Dept., seconded by Trustee Wooden, 4 ayes, CARRIED.

LOCAL LAW #4, PROHIBITED FIRST FLOOR APT. IN C-1 DISTRICT: Trustee Gilmore noted that a couple of mtgs. had been held to discuss this LL and Trustee Gilmore moved to accept LL#4 as written, seconded by Trustee Wooden, for the purpose of discussion: Trustee Wooden said he agreed with the concept of the LL but if the VB going to pass it, the LL #4 needed an overhaul at this time, noting that much good discussion came out of the LL#4 meetings. Trustee Wooden suggested that the Business Comm. be given a chance to act on changes before this LL is decided on. Mayor Elliott said that if the VB doesn't pass LL#4, comments on changes or additions or comments can be given to the Village Clerk. Trustee Gilmore requested these comments be for submission to the Planning Board on Weds. night. VOTE, Trustee Gilmore, aye, Trustee Wooden, nay, Trustee Drews, aye, Mayor Elliott, nay. Mayor Elliott not that voted down, at this time.

H. Baker asked if the minutes to the mtg. were kept concerning the comments by the business people etc.? Mayor Elliott noted that the community meeting after the public hearing was not a VB mtg. so official minutes were not taken. Trustee Wooden stated that he had a tape of the community mtg. H. Baker questioned Trustee Gilmore voting on the LL#4 without hearing the tape or the comments made by community people, and did the merchants know that the VB was going to vote on this tonight? Trustee Wooden said that the LL#4 was not specific enough and reminded all to get comments to VC for Pl. Bd. mtg.

BASEBALL PARADE: Trustee Gilmore commented that there were 4 officers + 1 Sheriff and approx. 600 children on the streets of Pal. on Saturday, and speaking to the press, saying that if a negative event would have been covered by all press, however, only 1 repre. was there from the press, and Trustee Gilmore thinks that the press should emphasize on the good. Trustee

Gilmore commended all those people involved in the parade and that it was well executed. Chief Dalton noted that they are very good kids. Trustee Gilmore noted that this is a representation of all good things that happen in a small community.

SIGNS: Trustee Drews noted that the Middle School Open House is next Thursday. The sign will be on display and Mary Jane Kates and Dave VanGorden were honored with the presentation of the Harvard-Ratcliff Club of Rochester Teacher Innovation Award. Ltr. received reads as follows:

I am delighted to inform you that your interdisciplinary sign project has been selected to received the 1993 Harvard-Ratcliffe Club of Rochester Teacher Innovation Award.

Our review committee was very impressed by the breadth of educational experiences and critical skills involved in this project. We saw particular merit in the team teaching, cooperative learning and community involvement that you incorporated in it.

We commend you both for your outstanding creativity, organizational skills and thoughtfulness in evaluation the program's effectiveness.

We invite you to be our guests at our Club's annual dinner meeting on May 19, 6:30 p.m. at the Country Club of Rochester where we will formally present the award to you. Your school principal will also be invited to accept the monetary grant.

This award is given for the first time in our area and the first time to a Middle School. Monetary award is \$1,000.

Trustee Drews noted that permission ltrs. would go out to the property owners on whose property the signs would be placed. The privilege boards will be 12" x 12" and the VOP Highway DEPT. will be digging the holes.

TRUSTEE WOODEN REPORTS ON MERCHANT AND PROPERTY OWNER MTG.:

Trustee Wooden reported that the main concerns of the merchants and property owners were PD coverage and parking. The northside and southside parking was discussed and better access for the southside parking lot was needed. Needing to investigate these items. Trustee Wooden has tapes and notes and will put them together another meeting in a couple of weeks.

SIDEWALKS: Trustee Gilmore noted that the worst sidewalk in the VOP appears to be Eleanor Drake's on Vienna Street. A ltr. from M. Crane's lawyer had been received concerning the sidewalk at the corner of Fayette and E. Main St. K. Diefendorf asked why there are no sidewalks on Howell St. and none on Crescent Dr. Response was don't know why.

H. Kruger suggested so many sidewalks in a certain area done per year until all the sidewalks are new. Trustee Gilmore stated that the VB is identifying the worst sidewalks and been replacing. Some sidewalks were run out by Dar Lin Lane and mostly replacing sidewalks in need not putting in new sidewalks.

E. Hartnagal noted that there were still slate sidewalks ie by Latchkey on W. Jackson Street. H. Kruger noted that sidewalk would be needed by the Comm. Ctr. Trustee Gilmore noted that a mtg. was held approx. 6 years ago on the sidewalks at the Comm. Ctr. only 1 person showed up and 1 person was interested. H. Kruger said he did not think it was an option. Trustee Gilmore explained no option if a matter of safety. Mayor Elliott noted

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that P. Retan had put sidewalks in the highway budget for this year. H. Kruger asked if the VB would let people know about sidewalks and Trustee Gilmore said he would push for sidewalks.

DEPUTY MAYOR LYNCH; DRAINAGE: A meeting with Sniedze Assoc. was held and a preliminary report was done. A mtg. with the residents next step.

DUMP TRUCK: Depty Mayor Lynch reported that the hydraulic lift broke and is being repaired at Lancaster, NY.

FLAG AND FLAGPOLE: Depty Mayor Lynch reported that the flag was stuck on the pole on top of the tower. H. Kruger said that he knew someone at Garlock's that does climbing and may be able to do the job and will check on it.

SEASONAL EMPLOYEE: The Highway Dept. would like to hire a seasonal employee, reported Depty Mayor Lynch. A motion was made by Depty Mayor Lynch to hire a fulltime seasonal employee ie student at \$2,800 approx. at a rate of \$6/hr. with an ad to go in the paper stating daily basis from June to Sept. Just 1 empl., seconded by Trustee Gilmore, 5 ayes, CARRIED.

REPORT ON EAST FOSTER ST. DRAINAGE: Mostly done on Southside of the road and draining -- some sediment in the area. Mayor Elliott noted that Mrs. Lape hung up clothes in her yard! Hurrah..

Depty Mayor Lynch reported that McGuire's won't sign an easement unless Ventorino will make the pond smaller. Mayor Elliott noted that is a mute point because the county did not need McGuire to sign easement and went around.

CATS: Chief Dalton asked about an article in the newspaper stating cats need to be immunized against rabies, and questioned ACO about picking up cats. ACO said she was not allowed to pick up cats. Trustee Wooden questioned the ACO and stated that the VOP law says pick up any animal causing a nuisance and noted that ACO had been told this at another meeting. ACO commented about the extra money it will cost the VOP if she is to pick up cats. Trustee Gilmore asked about cats and rabies if there were more rabid cat bites.

EXECUTIVE SESSION: A motion was made by Trustee Wooden and seconded by Mayor Elliott to go into Executive Session for matters of union negotiation discussion and personnel at 8:10 p.m. , vote, 5 ayes, CARRIED.

Motion by Trustee Gilmore and seconded by Trustee Drews to go out of Executive Session at 9:40 p.m., vote, 5 ayes, CARRIED.

ADJOURNMENT: A motion was made by Mayor Elliott and seconded by Trustee Drews to adjourn the meeting at 9:41 p.m., vote, 5 ayes, CARRIED.
