Citizen W. Heckman asked the reason for proposed increase in sewer rates and informed by the Mayor of increased costs for sewer plant operations (hauling sludge - liquid & dry). Mayor explained process re drying beds, pressing, etc. Trustee Pope sd. VOP annually places money in Sewer Reserve. Trustee Wooden spke. of metal content in sludge - high copper & nickel, sd. Mayor Elliott.....tested quarterly & annually according to State requirements.

Special Meeting, 11:30 a.m., 8/28/90 among Village Board members - Mayor J. Elliott; Trustees D. Gilmore, D. Wooden & T. Lynch. Absent: Trustee D. Pope. Employees present were: Hwy. Supt., P. Retan; C&P Supt., R. Weaver; W&WW Supt., H. Kruger & Chief D. Dalton, P.D. VB established mtg. to discuss VOP's needs over nxt. several yrs. re streets, sidewalks, etc.

Trustee Gilmore spke. of streets which need chip-sealing done to protect (maintenance) - what Hwy. Dept. shld. be doing...before VOP has chance to address - Jackson, Canal, etc., streets need maintenance/paving....resident on Tremont sd. ages since sd. street-wk. done there....Trustee Lynch sd. imp. to maintain streets which are 'good'. Trustee Wooden mentioned Vienna, Stafford, Fayette, Foster & Division. D. Gilmore sd. VOP cannot afford to keep a capable construction co. of doing needed type of work...more & better equipment...so many have to be laid off during winter.....he sd. chip-sealing "maintenance"/paving is "construction"....

VOP shld. lk. @ 5 yrs....culverts on Prospect St. need to be done - no need to fix road until culvert done...D. Dalton spke. of Jackson St. - checking wtr. lines first. Trustee Lynch asked H. Kruger about wtr. lines which needed replacing - he suggested looking @ Main St....put wtr. main on 'that' side near curb and one on 'this' (north) side in case of problems in future..easier.

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Trustee Lynch sd. Jackson St. must be done...milling now, per D. Gilmore....sd. he'd like engineer to look @ - see what kind of base is there....if re-done, wtr. lines good for 10 yrs. not good enough, per T. Lynch. H. Kruger sd. ductal water mains good for 50-75 yrs....believes only transite line in VOP...old line a lead-joint line...T. Lynch sd. maybe he cld. take a map and identify what under street (material)....street-by-street...maybe VOP cld. get \$\$\$'s re 'lead'....if street torn up to do wtr. line, use wtr. \$\$\$'s....help defray cost of doing street. H. Kruger sd. water service frm. main to ea. hse....curb-bx... wk. in street wld. vibrate old pipes/may leak. spke. re-doing of storm sewers, wtr. mains, culverts, etc. More VOP does, per T. Lynch, more possibilities of obtaining outside \$\$\$'s. D. Gilmore sd. many hses. have galvanized pipe....spke. of Vienna St. when residents had low pressure/replaced pipe frm. curb-box to hse....had to dig up road to get @ it. J. Elliott sd. all copper....dug up in sme. areas when gas main broke...H. Kruger sd. NYSEG....need coordination....plastic water mains...wld. suggest ductal piping only....flexible...high strength. Mayor asked if VOP to pave street (as in Jackson St.) - are there large amt. who still have old galvanized curb-box? H. Kruger talked of what occurred when H. VanEtten W&WW Supt. here (company out of Rochester), VOP gave villagers opportunity of hooking into new main being put in that passed their hses. Contractor attempted charging homeowners....some pd./some didn't....H. Kruger sd. 'cards' wld. be updated....go to ea. hse. on Jackson St. & check basement/what is coming out of wall...Mayor sd. his concern was for not frm. curb-box into hse./frm. curb-box to main...shut-off - where VOP responsibility ends....are there many in the VOP still galvanized....where involved digging up street for replacement...wld. behoove VOP to replace wth. copper. H. Kruger sd. he cld. check @ hses. - cld. locate curb-box...only other option wld. be to dig up....cases where when new copper service put in, used old curb-box....if street dug up for new mains (as on Vienna St.)...replaced whole main...rather than time, effort & money... if 12' main put in, put in copper...make sure hooked into existing service....weren't going to do on Vienna....wld. let homeowner or VOP hook it....shld. put main in line wth. existing service/attached properly. H.K. spke. of having an on-site engineer to watch every move contractor(s) make.

T.L. asked for any info. he (H.K.) cld. get for Bd. - ask Kerry to put in computer; D. Wooden sd. Kerry mde. list of all streets - additions can be mde. - conditions of streets, etc. H.K. spke. of clean-up in person's frnt. yds. after new sewer - difference of opinion whose responsibility; whoever does lateral does the cleanup. Talk of finding (Jud) undeveloped lots so that laterals and curb-boxes put in (dip on W. Foster @ end of Bird-sall mentioned)....sme. stubs were put in but never recorded.... cards must be updated....T.L. asked if any money available.... H. K. sd. 'someone' in Lyons who does wk. - Mayor sd. Sharon Lilla does it; D. Wooden sd. a network in Albany (called RAIN) of grants, loans, etc. '800' #...just give topic & they'll look up. J. Elliott sd. Cty. would do, also. H. Kruger sd. when any kind of organized mtg. held, NYSEG shld. be invited....main cables undergrnd., per Mayor. Although R. Weaver's dpt., any trees that shld. come out. Need to coordinate wth. all dpts., per D. Gilmore...notify residents. R. Weaver explained re trees...depends on species of trees...shld. do street-by-street survey of trees and put on computer...survey done 15 yrs. ago, but not in computer.

H. Kruger mentioned street lights...shld. be 'flavor' of Palmyra Mayor sd. NYSEG shld be notified when doing street...elevation problem on Vienna St. - re-did every service to the homes frm. the main to 'some' point. H. Kruger sd. 'pounder' to break up st. - cement underneath...machine broke up some connections... before he (H.K.) cld. oversee - vibrating the grnd. & broke old

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pipe. D. Gilmore sd. engineers sd. old cement shld. be removed, then on Park....concrete better for rd. base (different engineer, per Mayor)....sd. VB didn't listen to R. Smith & himself @ that time/took engineer's word. D. Gilmore sd. where Johnson St. comes into Vienna - bad, VOP will have lawsuit some day....cld. put 3' of fill bk. in, per Mayor....wld. cost.....disc. on cutting Johnson bk. - when cut bk. further, ran into problem per Mayor...because of brick hse. on corner - ran into their foundation...sme. driveways wld. end up like sme. on Vienna St. Trustee Lynch sd. survey shld. be done of streets - which ones need immediate attention - let H.K. & R.W. know. D. Wooden sd., as for locating curb-boxes, etc. - all shld. be done, however, shld. concentrate on Jackson/Canal Sts. D. Gilmore sd. VB talked of Canal St....put off for a reason - major work to be done. D. Dalton sd. "on bk. burner no parking between sidewlk./curb." Instituted to get rid of McCreary's motor home on Liberty. Canal St. a problem in wintertime.. no designated edge of highway...P. Retan will have same problem...will we make it "no parking" or what???? D. Gilmore sd. no parking anyway between 2-7 a.m. T. Lynch mentioned Prospect Dr. - VOP liable, sd. D. Dalton... whoever paints it....paint a double yellow stripe down ctr. of road..they park on one side, forcing people to park on opposite side of street...what if a collision if they aren't marked, per D. Gilmore...not as liable, sd. D. Dalton....right-of-way... by definition...forcing them across. D. Gilmore sd. put there for that reason....so people cld. identify lanes better...D. Dalton agreed that it belongs there....shld. not be any parking on that st. - frm. fire hydrant @ entrance to "Carriage Stop" on to Mill shld. be no parking.....5 homes involved. D. Wooden sd. shld. be no parking on Fayette St. - or make Fayette one-way...discussion on fire trks. going through...Jackson to Main re businesses... hardware store....3/4 of people go south to Walker St. & up & around...D. Wooden sd. he'd make it (Fayette) one-way southbound...few come in Foster & north-bound...D. Dalton agreed wth. D. Wooden...more accessible...Mayor Elliott sd. VB had discussed in past making Fayette one-way....if mde. one-way, D. Wooden asked if feasible to make it frm. Main to Jackson south frm. E. Foster to Jackson north??? then emptying everything onto Jackson St. which is busy street. Wld. confuse people, per D. Dalton. D. Wooden's orig. idea better...make one-way frm. Main south - whole street...take R. Weaver & Phil in biggest VOP trucks.... measure frm. trk. to curb to see whether can get through (mentioning husband of Helga who drives DOT trk.)... see if "snork" can get through....if trk. can't get through, eliminate parking there...Mayor sd. if VB considers making one-way southbound, logical to switch parking frm. east side to west side...D. Wooden agreed...discussion....Bd. pondered..width of street discussed - narrowest st. in VOP...17' in one spot (near Gerber's), per D. Wooden...big problem wth. 2-way traffic coming off Prosp. or E. Jackson onto Fayette St., VOP allows parking there...just enough rm. for one car to sit & wait for traffic....D. Wooden cited coming off Jackson, turn rt. on Fayette St., going south....if a car @ Stop sign....must turn very carefully...T. Lynch asked for a street like Fayette, do curb & sidewlk. like W. Foster...wld. lose sme. trees...why not offer homeowner...VOP wld. lose responsibility for sd. trees...also, when trees get bigger wld. not tear up sidewlk. - may or may not per Mayor...Fayette has narrow right-of-way...present curb-line is about @ right-of-way - looked up once....narrow st. - in sme. places, road not in right-of-way anymore....beyond what is legally VOP's....R. Weaver commented on 'sticking' them bk. in yard....D. Wooden sd. cld. be done frm. Main to Walker & not lose that much....T. Lynch sd. why not give the trees to residents....H.K. spke. of curb-boxes..some in sidewlks. Mayor sd. some in sidewlk. on Vienna, south side. R. Weaver sd. if big, silver maples removed - gives shade to people - didn't think people wld. be happy...not everyone going to be happy, per D. Gilmore. D. Wooden, living there, knew the trees in the area of Fayette. People like tree-lined streets, per Mayor.

H. K. asked if Jackson & Canal still under consideration...D. Wooden asked P. Retan who sd. have to consider streets wth. biggest traffic...got to consider E. Foster. H.K. asked about history of Canal - concrete underneath??? Wasn't it Route #31 at one time? Per Mayor, "no" - main business st. @ one time. Vienna was Rt. #31.....sd. Throop a brick st. @ one time... D. Wooden asked if Canal cld. be widened....south side...to put curb/sidewlk. where it is now - and have parking space - can't tell where it is now....wld. there be room for traffic...D. Dalton sd. Clinton wld. be problem....wth. Garlock traffic, can't mke. two lanes just wth. parking - wld. be sme. as Vienna St. - wide enough to get east & west traffic + a parking lane. "No" per P. Retan citing Holmes, etc. If Canal done, wld. be 'nice' to do streets up to Main, per T. Lynch....D. Gilmore sd. cld. do 'no parking' frm. Pomponio's east on either side...D. Dalton sd. all that's there garage & backyrd. going to gas station...shld. be frm. gas station all way down...no parking on either side of st. - make st. wider, per D. Wooden. D. Dalton - wld. have to take Pomponio's barn...spke. of yellow hse., north side., 3-apt. bldg. on Clinton wld. have to go....trees between sidewalk./road edge....engineer cld. probably survey for widening/straightening by adding sme. on ea. side., more room....D. Wooden sd. if curb/sidewlk. combination, moved them, save trees...two lanes of traffic wth. no parking - P. Retan agreed only way feasible. Mayor sd. any street wth. no parking, hard on residents, company comes....D. Gilmore sd. if company parks & person's hse. catches on fire down street & trk. can't get through....cld. be real problem.

Surfacing, again, was problem of parking on Canal...D. Wooden sd. make two lanes of traffic....no parking...taking small VOP side st. for parking (J. DeFrain uses as private parking area, per D. Dalton)....wld. provide parking for 10 or more cars...T. Lynch asked about making a 'service' road in back of hses. Question asked if Hwy. Dept. wld. always be there - or projected to move to Kent sme. day...D. Wooden mentioned "Canal Project" 'some day' - can't buy/cld. lease, VOP shld. put in applic. for first access to it....Macedon already applied.. D. Gilmore sd. note to John - begin process. Mayor sd. he'd like to see park down there - D. Wooden sd. VOP shld. apply for first access for entire Village....then VOP cld. decide who wld. develop. Mayor sd. Fairport did...keep 15' along Canal...sell rest...put a walk-through park....worked well for Fairport.

P. Retan sd. no money available; if money - Jackson/Canal Sts. need to be done....Hyde Pkwy. needs work soon more of a process than "chip-sealing" due to buses....T. Lynch sd. Vienna & Stafford down for "chip-sealing." Hyde Pkwy., Vienna, Stafford, Division, Foster W. & Dar-Lind which have to be maintained....D. Gilmore sd. Aldrich shld. be added....P. Retan sd. 4/10 mi. of street - curbing on both sides, paved wth. VOP buying materials, Town doing dumping...talking \$90,000. Streets in VOP which need nothing other than maintenance...Vienna, Park Dr., Dar-Lind, W. Foster, per D. Wooden. P. Retan added Howell, Fayette & Stafford Sts. done....3 more yrs. before "chip-sealing".....T. Lynch sd. set up schedule/stick to it...have Kerry put in computer....H.K. spke. of sidewalks. on Spring/Fayette - mde. of blacktop....if any @ all...P. Retan spke. of long sidewalk. request list.

D. Gilmore sd. approx. \$7500. (sidewlks. labor) & \$4500. (material)...running out of time...curb cut-outs (6) for handicapped costing about \$5000. - T. Lynch asked about doing every corner....shld. be done 'handicapped' as they are done, per Mayor....255 blks. of slate sidewalks. to be replaced, per P. Retan....T. Lynch asked if removed in a slab or in pcs. - depends, per P. Retan....T. Lynch asked if people wanted it - sme. in vault (though rough). Some people show interest, per D. Gilmore - but it is thick. D. Wooden sd. in frnt. of Dr.

Sweeney's (Jackson) shld. be @ top of list...T. Lynch spke. of dangerous situation being brt. to VB's attention - if not tended to & someone hurt, VOP liable....dangerous, also @ Heumann's hse. on Stafford - just as bad as Sweeney's....VOP's cost per block disc. by Bd. D. Gilmore sd. VOP takes out old sidewlks. - have Brad Jacobs put in new. D. Gilmore spke. of slate sidewlks. in area of Miss Cook's hse. (corner - Jackson/Canandaigua) - cld. save maybe a couple....easier to take it all out & replace. D. Gilmore mentioned the danger of child falling near Elem. Schl. & Mrs. A. Curran falling/injured jaw as she walked wth. her hands in her pckts. Another place on southeast corner - Jackson/Cuyler. Never will have to take that out....ripples in it...slate poses a danger on Canandaigua for school children...also Canaltown Days...Phil sd. curbing on both sides, re-paving 2"....wld. run \$22,500. for 1/10th mile...any street in VOP. He spke. of CHIPS money, up to \$20,000./VOP able to do four streets frm. CHIPS...

H.K. spke. of grants re W&WW - more apt. to get than for streets. Primary project a new water main...T. Lynch still felt of all money put into water fund, sme. cld. be diverted for other uses when combining wth. water line replacemnt., etc. Phil R. sd. water line has to go in within nxt. yr. or so on E. Foster. H.K. sd. that in Fall VOP will not be pumping water across Canal north...will be fed by Macedon - less stress on VOP's facilities...raw water line will be here long time - nothing wrong wth. it. Money that's there shld. be used, per H.K. When Vienna St. done, Mayor sd. VOP pd. 50% of reconstruction costs with 50% bond issue....because destruction of street (destroyed by putting in wtr. line)...cld. be re-billed to water. T. Lynch spke. of putting about \$150,000. per yr. into water line...just the interest...wld. like not to put it in and use elsewhere. Questionable whether or not cld. be used, he sd. H.K. spke. of all being connected..."transmission" - sd. auditors separate because of Garlock's visibility...T. Lynch sd. that 'someone' had to vote upon @ smetime. - done on yearly basis, per Mayor. Money has to remain within Water Fund....only method is by doing streets....VB discussion...D. Gilmore sd. D. Pope explained it as the VB being on the Bd. of three different corporations...when having to do wth. money, per Mayor. Further discussion - several talkers, sme. of which cld. not be interpreted. T. Lynch spke. of his conversation wth. R. McMasters re using water monies....

Trustee Gilmore had to leave for an appointment....prior to which he moved adjournment @ 1:15 p.m.; Mayor seconded. All voted "aye"/carried.

Present: James G. Elliott, Mayor; Trustees C. D. Gilmore, Daniel E. Wooden, Daniel S. Pope III & Thomas N. Lynch; and Village Atty., John B. Nesbitt, Esq. (Department Hds. - P.D. Chief D. Dalton; W&WW Supt., H. Kruger; C&P Supt., R. Weaver & Hwy. Supt. P. Retan arrived @ approx. 8:00 p.m. having been asked by the VB to attend for the purpose of a round-table discussion of "compensatory time" and "overtime".)

LL#1 re

Elec. Insp.: Local Law #1, 1990 re "Electrical Inspection Law" having been properly placed on VB desks for five (5) days and properly advertised, Mayor Elliott opened the public hearing asking for comments frm. the VB

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and the public. Mr. Robert Lester of Fire Underwriters was present to lend his expertise if needed. Mrs. E. Hartnagel asked if exclusive company performing inspections and informed by the Mayor that it cld. be more than one. Mr. Lester sd. that Fire Underwriters performing inspections for CEO J. Roney @ no cost to the VOP - a not-for-profit for corporation. Mayor Elliott sd. whomever performs inspections - must meet criteria, i.e. carry insurance, agree to provide copies of rpt. to the VOP, provide a schedule of rates.

Trustee Lynch asked if for new construction and told by Mayor that it was his understanding that it cld. be or on older remodeled bldg. in which major electrical work done - must be inspected before electric turned on. Mr. Lester sd. that usually the Local Law has provisions for company the municipality engages - one or more - up to VB. Trustee Lynch questioned cost involved for builder or person remodeling; Mr. Lester sd. his company has a published price sheet (required by State) - identical throughout the State...cost based upon amt. of work performed and materials...he gave examples of different size houses...\$40.-\$50.....larger hses...\$70.-\$80. P. Retan asked about 'conduit' & Mr. Lester spke. of several kinds of acceptable wiring services...places of public assembly requirements vary. Trustee Lynch asked if CEO Roney recommends VOP participation and informed by the Mayor that he has recommended as did Mr. D. Wooden when he was CEO.

Mayor Elliott asked for further questions/comments - and when there were none, he declared the hearing closed @ 7:14 p.m.

Trustee Pope asked for clarification regarding the "Rogers Memorial Chapel" @ the Palmyra Cemetery on which pointing being done on brick-work; it was stated that the Chapel was built by Mr. Carlton Rogers in 1886 in memory of his father & family. Trustee Gilmore moved VB acceptance of the 8/20/90 VB Minutes; Trustee Pope seconded. Voting was unanimous.

8/28/90:

Minutes of the Spec. Mtg. held on 8/28/90 were incomplete.

C&P Depts.:

Trustee Lynch reported that ltr. rec'd frm. the painting contractor (trim on P&C Bldg.) stating his inability to accomplish the work. He stated that the C&P employees, by renting scaffolding, had hoped to paint but wld. be unable to do same in 1990 due to other commitments. Pump jacks and planks less expensive, per P. Retan and he asked about sand-blasting. Cld. affect wood he was told; short VB discussion on members of VB and volunteers scraping and painting the trim. No decision mde. Mr. Lynch to check wth. Mr. Gil Bryant as suggested by Mrs. E. Hartnagel, however, in all probability will have to wait until Spring.

Hwy Dept.:

Trustee Gilmore sd. awaiting scheduling of milling E. Foster St. He sd. Hwy. Supt. to attend Hwy Conference frm. 10/15-10/18/90 @ Lake Placid. Mr. Gilmore sd. that chipping wld. cease following first week in Oct. - Clerk to place ad in newspaper ea.
