The meeting was conducted in the offices of the Village Attorney, 122 Cuyler Street, Palmyra, New York.

CALL TO At 6:30 p.m., Mayor Strong called the meeting to order stating that Said meeting had been called for purposes of personnel and potential litigation and any other business taht may be brought before said meeting.

EXEC SESS Trustee Rolland moved that the Board exercise Executive Session; Trustee Elliott seconded. All voted "aye," carried.
