

Chapter 104

FIREARMS AND AIR GUNS

§ 104-1. Use of air, B.B. and pellet guns prohibited.

No person under the age of 16 years shall use, discharge or carry loaded within the boundaries of the Village of Palmyra a gun commonly known as a “pellet,” “B.B.” or “air” gun, a gun from which a shot or pellet may be discharged by a spring of air.

§ 104-2. Use of shell or cartridge guns restricted. [Amended 2-11-1964¹]

No person shall discharge a gun loaded with shell or cartridge, or any air gun, spring gun, or other instrument or weapon in which the propelling force is a spring or air, except a duly authorized peace officer or a member of a duly organized rifle, gun or pistol club while such member is engaged in practice or competition on a range approved by the Chief of Police or officer in charge of the Palmyra Police Department. No person shall carry loaded within the boundaries of the Village of Palmyra a gun loaded with shell or cartridge except a duly authorized peace officer or a person authorized under the provisions of § 265.35 of the Penal Law of the State of New York.

§ 104-3. Penalties for offenses.²

Any person who shall violate any provision of this chapter, and any person who aids, abets or assists therein, shall be punishable, upon conviction, by a fine not exceeding \$250 or a term of imprisonment not exceeding 15 days, or both, for each violation, and if any person who shall violate any provisions of this chapter be under the age of 16 years, any police officer shall confiscate any gun owned or possessed by said person.
