PARKS AND RECREATION AREAS

GENERAL REFERENCES

ARTICLE I
Use of Parks and Cemeteries
[Adopted 10-15-2007 by L.L. No. 2-2007¹]

§ 132-1. Definitions.

The words and terms used in this article, unless otherwise expressly stated, or unless the context or subject matter otherwise requires, shall have the same meaning as defined in the Vehicles and Traffic Law and Conservation Law of the State of New York.

§ 132-2. Certain vehicles prohibited.

No person shall operate, stand or park any motorcycle, all-terrain vehicle, minibike or snowmobile at any time upon any portion of the Village property commonly known as "Prospect Hill Park."

§ 132-3. Hours of parks and cemeteries.

All parks and cemeteries in the Village of Palmyra shall be closed and not open to the public each day between sunset and sunrise.

§ 132-4. Repealer.

All other ordinances or parts of ordinances of the Village of Palmyra inconsistent with the provisions of this article are hereby repealed; provided, however, that such repeal shall be only to the extent of such inconsistency and in all other respects this article shall be in addition to the other ordinances regulating and governing the subject matter covered by this article.

§ 132-5. Penalties for offenses.

If any person shall violate the provisions of this article, said person shall be punished by a fine of up to \$100 for a first offense; a fine of up to \$250 for a second offense; a fine of up to \$500 for a third offense; a fine of \$1,000 for a fourth offense; and a fine of \$2,000 for a fifth offense. In addition to specified fines, violators are subject to imprisonment for up to 15 days.
