CALL TO ORDER: Mayor Daly called the meeting to order at 5:00 p.m.

PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

NEW/OLD BUSINESS:

SMALL CITIES GRANT APPLICATION: Trustee Celentano moved to adoption the following resolution:

RESOLVED, that the Mayor of the Village of Palmyra, Wayne County, New York is hereby authorized as the official representative of the Village to execute and submit a Small Cities application for the Fiscal Year 2003 program, all understandings and assurances contained therein, and is hereby directed and authorized to act in connection with the submission of the application and to provide such additional information as may be required.

SEASONAL HELP – BUILDINGS AND GROUNDS MAINTENANCE/HWY
